Policies (2026-2027)

Parking Lot: Please exercise caution in the parking lot by looking for students and pedestrians when parking and backing up your vehicle. The west-most parking stall directly in front of the facility can be difficult to back out of due to the dumpster enclosure. Do not allow children to play in the parking lot or near the dumpster. Note that the speed limit on Locust Grove Road is reduced at various times of the day as it is part of a school zone.

Drop-off and Pick-up: Students should arrive approximately five minutes before the beginning of class. They should come in proper dance attire which may be worn under street clothes and should not dress in the waiting areas. Students are encouraged to use the restroom before or after class in order to make full use of class time. They need to be picked up promptly at the end of class. Note that TVBA and its instructors do not supervise students outside of enrolled classes. This includes before/after class, outside the building, and at offsite rehearsals/performances.

Waiting Areas: Viewing windows are installed in the waiting areas for guests to view class. However, parents/guardians are not required to remain for the duration of class. Please note that many students participate better in class when they do not have regular observers. Those in the waiting areas should be respectful of others by holding conversations at a considerate volume. Please supervise children for their safety and to ensure they do not disturb others or mar the facility. Bringing food or drink into the waiting areas is discouraged in order to keep the facility clean. Valuables should not be left in the waiting areas.

Dance Equipment: The marley flooring, barres, mirrors, audio-visual equipment, and props etc. are valuable tools for dance instruction. To avoid costly damage and more importantly physical injury, please note the following. Avoid touching the mirrors, windows, and audio-visual equipment. Barres and props are not to be used without supervision and hanging on the barres is not permitted. Street shoes are not allowed on the marley flooring.

Dress Code: Street clothes should not be worn in class. Boys should wear a plain white T-shirt, black dance pants, and black ballet shoes. Girls should wear pink tights, a dance leotard, and pink ballet shoes. Their hair should be worn away from their face in a bun. Please note that underwear is unnecessary under tights and leotards. Dance skirts are allowed through Primary Ballet, but only after barre in upper-level classes. Split sole ballet shoes are recommended for Primary Ballet and up. Please tie shoe laces in a knot and tuck them under. Tutus, costumes, shorts, and other cover-ups should not be worn in regular classes.

Absences and Withdrawal: Attendance at every class is important for progression and also for learning choreography. However, students should not attend class if they are ill or contagious. Please notify the Academy if consecutive classes will be missed. Enrollment typically constitutes a commitment to participate for the duration of the dance season (September – May). TVBA must be notified in writing or by email of early withdrawal. Note that tuition is still due through the month in which the Academy receives notification.

Canceled Classes: The Academy will not usually hold class on days when West Ada School District cancels school due to inclement weather, public health, or safety concerns. Classes beginning 3 PM or later may be canceled if the district cancels after school events for the above causes. Please check email for any TVBA class cancellations.

Miscellaneous: Harassment of any kind will not be tolerated. TVBA reserves the right to refuse service. Pets with the exception of trained service animals and weapons with an exception for law enforcement are not permitted at the facility or TVBA events. Professional medical advice should be sought as needed; instructors are not medical professionals. Supplemental policies may be posted online or at the facility and may be revised throughout the season. Upper-level students please also reference the Ballet Etiquette and Pointe Technique supplements.

Tuition and Fees (2026-2027)

- Monthly tuition amount *per student*:
 - Pre-Ballet 1-4 (*ages 3+*): 45 minute weekly class \$54/month
 - Primary Ballet 1-2 (*ages 7+*): 60 minute weekly class \$63/month; twice weekly \$107/month
 - Ballet 1 (*ages 9+*): 75 minute weekly class \$72/month; twice weekly \$116/month
 - Ballet 2-3 (*ages 10+*): two 75 minute technique weekly \$116/month
 - Ballet 4 (*ages 12+*): two 75 minute technique and one 60 minute pointe weekly \$144/month
 - Ballet 5/6 (*ages 13+*): two 90 min tech and one 90 min pointe weekly \$170/mo; with var \$196/mo
 - Ballet 7/8 (*ages 15+*): two 90 min tech and two 90 min pointe weekly \$196/mo; with var \$222/mo
 - Adult Ballet: 75 minute weekly class \$72/month
 - Tuition for individual instruction: \$52/hour
 - Please email or call for tuition rates applicable to other class options or combinations
- Costume fee *per costume* due with registration for Winter Showcase and by January 9, 2027 for Season Finale:
 - Pre-Ballet levels \$45; Primary Ballet levels \$50; Ballet levels \$55
 - Fees are non-refundable once class orders are placed; Season Finale fee increases \$10 after Jan. 16, '27
 - Typically one costume per performance through Ballet 1, two for Ballet 2-4, three for Ballet 5-8 w/var
- Registration fee: \$25 non-refundable; \$20 if paid by July 25, 2026 (emailed, in-person, or postmarked)
- Other costs: performance tickets and optional class portraits

Advance Pay Discount: A discount of 3% off tuition can be applied if the full nine months is paid at registration.

Family Discounts: A discount of 10% off tuition and also \$5 off the registration fee can be applied to each concurrent student from the same immediate family.

Tuition Details: Tuition is due by the 1st of each month September through May. There is a \$5 late fee for tuition not paid or postmarked by the 10th. Tuition is monthly based and not prorated for absences, withdrawals, or days the Academy does not hold class. Tuition must be current prior to participation in performances.

Payments: Payment options in order of preference are ACH auto-draft, check, or cash. To initiate auto-draft please submit the ACH Payments Form (ensures no late fees). The ACH Payments Form can be returned by email, mail, or placed in the tuition drop-box inside the facility. If paying by check or cash, please indicate the student for whom payment is being made. Checks should be made payable to *TVBA* and can be sent by mail or placed in the drop-box. A service fee of \$20 is due on any rejected ACH payment or returned check.
